Nicole had breast cancer, which had spread to her lungs, and she was on oxygen therapy for the last 4 weeks of her life. Because of this, she could not leave the hospital and was scared, extremely uncomfortable, and upset.

Then #teamqueenscourt stepped in and offered her a beautiful room where she felt safe and extremely well cared for, and where she could finally relax.

The care afforded to her was second to none. She and her family and friends all felt the huge amount of love and support that every person who works at Queenscourt freely gave, passing on the strength that we all needed to cope with those last precious weeks with her.

I wish everyone's last days could be so full of kindness, love, support, and calm reassurance.

For me personally, it made her passing a little easier to bear.

Nicole's time at Queenscourt was an absolute blessing, and I will never be able to thank them enough.

"Lion Heart" to me portrays the huge amount of courage and dignity that Nicole showed, plus the enormous hearts of those who work at Queenscourt.

I will be forever grateful.

Our Education Centre

The Terence Burgess Education Centre (TBEC) is named after Mr Terence Burgess, Surgeon at Southport and Ormskirk District General Hospital.

Mr Burgess was instrumental in establishing the Education Centre with the founder of Queenscourt Hospice, Dr Karen Groves and was the first Chairman of the Queenscourt Board of Trustees.

TBEC opened in 2001 and now offers a wide range of interactive courses to enable those in caring roles to be informed and confident as they confront challenging situations and put theory into practice.

TBEC serves as a purpose-built teaching hub within Queenscourt Hospice and facilities are available to support on-line and face-to-face education.

Queenscourt at Home

Our Queenscourt at Home Team provide support for patients across West Lancashire, Southport and Formby. This vital outreach service allows those who can, to be cared for in the comfort of their own home.

Working as part of the Queenscourt at Home Team, Queenscourt's Health Care Assistants (HCA's) spend a period of time either during the day or overnight in the patient's own home, providing essential compassionate care and support.

This around-the -clock service works in partnership with local GPs, District Nurses and existing community organisations to ensure that our patients receive exceptional palliative care, when they need it the most.





Our Tranquil Garden Room

Updates from #teamqueenscourt

The refurbishment of our Garden Room has been a wonderful collaboration between our Ward and Fundraising colleagues, working together to improve our hospice and the care we can offer to families.

The Garden Room is a private space to visit a loved one after they have died. It allows families to take their time and be with their loved one, hold them if they wish, and say their final goodbyes. The importance of these moments is immense, and holds a special place in people's memories forever.



The refurbishment has only been possible thanks to the Hodge Foundation, who awarded us a grant of £5,000 to cover all the costs involved. With their help we are delighted to have transformed the Garden Room from a clinical setting into a beautiful, tranquil space, that offers warmth and comfort to families when they need it most.




Bringing Comfort and Joy - Queenscourt's Therapy Dogs

Margaret Tarpey


